



DELIVERY FORMAT OF THE COURSE

This course is offered in an **INSTRUCTOR-LED** format. The online instructor-led courses are offered in a personalized mode with no more than 30 students in each class. Start and finish dates are clearly marked. Besides the online tools used for interaction in the virtual environment, courses provide students with continuous support from a technical assistant, the tutor, and a program coordinator, who are experts in the course topics, and can offer effective feedback in all course activities and promote relevant discussion.

Principles for Reviewing Environmental Impact Assessments

Online course



This course is designed to provide practical guidance to professionals involved in the review and evaluation of Environmental Impact Assessments. It is aimed at professionals who participate in the process of reviewing proposed projects, policies, or programs and/or those working on environmental protection and management, social or natural sciences, public management, etc. and who review and evaluate the results of EISAs carried out by others. It applies to a range of legal, institutional, and cultural scenarios and to be used by reviewers from any country where EISA are conducted. The course covers:

- The EIA process and the role of the reviewer
- Evaluation of an Environmental Impact Assessment document
- Preparation and communication of the reviewer's comments
- Resources for the reviewer

Who should take this course?

The Principles for Reviewing EIA Course is primarily intended for people involved in the evaluation of Social and Environmental Impact Assessments (EISAs) and management plans for government approval but may also be useful for those who are responsible for writing EISAs.

Please note that this course will have one **optional** synchronous session (live session to attend a specific day and time through videoconference) to be held during module 1, on Wednesday at 4:30 PM, Washington time.
